

Mandy Jakich is the host of the Creative
Matters podcast. Mandy is an artist herself, an experienced teacher, art educator, art practitioner and visual arts facilitator and the founder and CEO of art education business Creative Matters.

The Creative Matters
podcast is the only one
of its kind in Aotearoa.
Established in March
2021, with 110
published episodes as
of February 2024.
Podcast episodes are
generally published
weekly, with short
breaks in between
seasons at times.

In each episode Mandy talks to a New Zealand artist or an artist living in New Zealand about their creative journey from childhood, their art practice and creative process. Guests are from diverse communities such as the rainbow or LGBTQ community; immigrants; youth; established artists; emerging artists; Pasifika and Maori and come from different backgrounds and experiences.

Each episode is a permanent archive of Aotearoa NZ social history. The podcast is an educational resource which is encouraging, accessible and inspirational.

Longevity

Podcast episodes remain accessible indefinitely and downloads continue to grow over time.

Ergagement

A loyal and supportive listener base which grows every time we have a new guest/episode as new audiences are reached through the guest artist's connections and database.

Marketing

As well as our own podcast promotion and marketing, each guest promotes their episode on their social media and to their email database. Each artist is given a code so they can embed their episode permanently onto their website. A blogpost on the Creative Matters website is written for each guest with the podcast episode and images of their work.
